Instructors

All classes are taught by Londyn Skye Dance Center, Llc faculty, under the direction of Niasia Coulson, Executive Artistic Director at Londyn Skye Dance Center.

Students

Classes are open to students age 3 to adult. Students are organized by age and skill level. We happily welcome both, students with an innate passion for dance as well as energetic dance amateurs looking to have fun!

Dress Code

Students must respect dress code and are required to come to class properly attired for training. This is to optimize dancing conditions, comfort, discipline and hygiene.

BALLET

Girls should arrive to Ballet class in black leotard, pink tights, and pink ballet slippers; ballet skirt or pink waist-ribbon optional. Boys should arrive to Ballet class in black pants, white t-shirt or tank top, and black ballet slippers.

MODERN AND ACROBATICS

All students should arrive to Modern class barefoot in black leotard and black tights; form fitting black shorts optional.

TAP AND JAZZ

Girls should arrive to Jazz/Tap class in black leotard, black tights, and black jazz/tap shoes; black jazz/tap pants optional. Boys should arrive to Jazz/Tap class in black jazz/tap pants, white t-shirt or tank top, and black jazz/tap shoes.

HIP-HOP

Students should arrive to Hip Hop class in clothing in which they are able to move comfortably and sneakers; no jeans.

Classes

The Londyn Skye Dance Center offers high quality classes in a variety of dance techniques including: Ballet, Hip-Hop, Modern, Tap and Jazz, Acrobatics.

CULTURE AND MILESTONES

Demo classes and showcases are hosted periodically to introduce new techniques and keep our students current and excited with the dance world. Students are tested through a series of presentations and auditions throughout each term to be admitted to higher level courses. Beginner, Junior and Senior level students have the opportunity to perform at events and represent school in competitions. Parents and audience are also invited to periodical recitals to observe student progress and socialize with school and faculty.

TRANSFER AUDITION POLICY

Students transferring from other schools or studios must schedule a placement audition before registering, and submit proof of prior enrollment with application. This process ensures that student are placed in a class where they can exercise their full potential and feel more comfortable with their peers.

Tuition and Fees

REGISTRATION FEE

There is a \$30 non-refundable registration fee due with tuition payment at enrollment. Fee for late registration is \$45. Late registration begins a month after official registration date.

TUITION

Spring/Fall Semester 12 classes a month

Pre-Ballet (Ages 3 – 8)\$100/mo. or \$450/tm.

Beginners (Ages 9 – 12).....\$100/mo. or \$450/tm.

Junior (Ages 13 – 17).....\$100/mo. or \$450/tm.

Senior (Ages 18 – Adult)\$120/mo. or \$500/tm.

Summer Session

20 classes a month

Beginners (Ages 5 – 12) \$900/tm.

Junior (Ages 13 – 17).....\$900/tm.

Payment plans are available for summer, please inquire at admission desk.

Acrobatics are \$100 extra on tuition costs for spring and fall semesters, but are included in summer session.

PAYMENT POLICY

Payments must be made by deadline. Late payments will incur in a \$30 late fee. Term payments are due at registration in full. Monthly payments are due at deadline every month, with first and second month due at registration. No exceptions.
